The works made during the Symposium will be placed on the concrete postaments around the Lopota Lake area. Please keep in mind that the works must be around 100-180 cm. There is no theme, the artistic aesthetics of the works will be chosen by the Host and Sponsors

THINGS ARTISTS NEED TO TAKE INTO ACCOUNT:

MAIN MATERIAL USED IN OUR SYMPOSIUM:

Ceramic Symposium consists of works of art with ceramic works.

The Symposium's main material is stoneware (or Chamotte) which has 1100-1150 degrees and fired color is white.

The materials will be provided by Sponsors. Please take your favorite tools with you.

SPECIAL MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS:

If there are special requirements, the symposium organization team tries to meet these requirements as possible. (However, please give details, such as dimensions, weight, color, quantity etc. of the required special materials.)

• KILNS SPECIFICATIONS:

There are three 1150-degrees gas kilns with 1m, 0,8 volumes for firing the works, 1 raku kiln.
